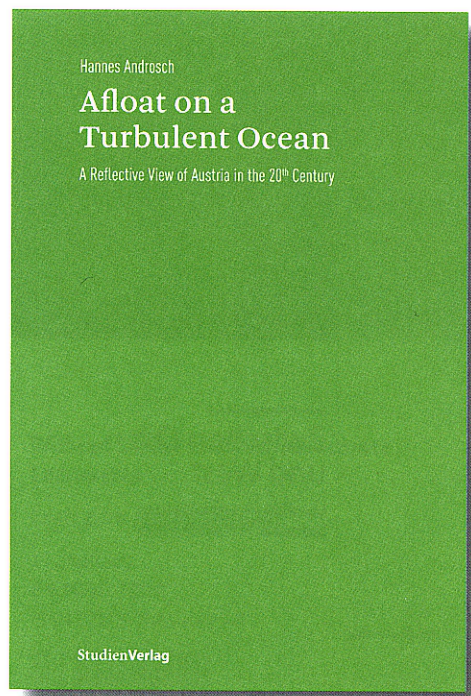
Afloat on a Turbulent Ocean

Dr. Hannes Androsch was born in Vienna, Austria in 1938. In the 1970s and 1980s he was one of the foremost politicians in the country, serving in successive Bruno Kreisky administrations as finance minister and vice-chancellor. After leaving politics, he served as general director of the Creditanstalt-Bankverein and as a consultant with the World Bank. Today, Dr. Androsch holds a range of industrial enterprises, in addition to his activities in scientific and cultural institutions.
